### Camper Input

# FIELD TRIP WEEK (AGES 4-8)


### WEEK 9: August 12-16 | Full Day \$700

# ACADEMIC CAMPS WITH CONNECTIONS ACADEMICS (AGES 4-10)

#### READING ENRICHMENT CAMP DATES/GRADE LEVEL:

Rising Junior Kindergarten June 17th - June 28th Rising Senior Kindergarten June 17th - June 28th Rising 1st Grade July 8 - July 19th Rising 2nd Grade July 8 - July 19th TIME: 9:00 am - 12:00 pm COST: \$1050

This course, held at Bennett Day School, will use the Orton Gillingham Method to provide early literacy instruction to elementary aged students in a fun and engaging way. The Orton Gillingham Method is a research backed method of reading instruction that is particularly effective with students who have difficulty with reading and writing. A licensed teacher will provide daily direct instruction of reading, writing, and spelling strategies in a small group setting. Through repetitive and structured lessons, students begin to understand the foundations of phonics, including decoding, phonemic awareness, fluency and articulation. This course will present students with hands-on, peer interactive activities to create high engagement while practicing the foundational skills of reading, writing, and spelling. Each day will include a themed storytime, take-home craft, outdoor activities and interactive content instruction.

### **CREATIVE WRITING CAMP**

### DATES: June 17- June 28th TIME: 9:00 am - 12:00 pm COST: \$950

### GRADE LEVEL: Rising 2nd - Rising 4th Grade

Calling all young authors! This camp, held at Bennett Day School, will focus on a variety of writing strategies including planning/ brainstorming, drafting, determining main idea and supporting details, proofreading, peer editing, and many more. Taught by a licensed teacher, the course will also provide direct instruction of writing skills such as sentence structure, writing conventions, and spelling. Students will be guided through a number of engaging writing activities to practice skills necessary to generate their final writing piece. Each day, students will also participate in themed read-alouds and crafts to get their creativity going. During camp, students will be working towards the final step of writing, where they will be given the opportunity to "publish" all of their hard work in their very own takehome book! Groups will be divided by grade level (2nd & 3rd, 4th & 5th).

### SUMMER STEM CAMP

DATES: July 8 - July 19th TIME: 9:00 am - 12:00 pm COST: \$950

### GRADE LEVEL: Rising 2nd - Rising 4th Grade

This two-week camp will give students the opportunity to explore Science, Technology, Engineering & Math concepts in a fun, interactive and engaging way as they prepare for the upcoming school year. Sessions will be led by highly qualified and licensed teachers. Through repetitive and structured lessons, as well as projects, crafts and activities, students will have the opportunity to sharpen their STEM skills while having fun with their peers. Using a low instructor to student ratio is key in this camp and ensures successful delivery of content to bridge the gap to summer learning.

### 1-ON-1 TUTORING
